



Adopt a Community Venue Guidelines

In the early 2000's a young man found his way to the rooms of Narcotics Anonymous when he saw a flyer posted in the window of a Barber Shop, so you never know.

- Putting up leaflets, posters and displaying literature and meeting lists is a great way to make NA more visible in the community. This campaign includes choosing where to place posters and literature, contacting facilities to request permission, and following up on a monthly basis to ensure the literature is up to date.
- Find a community venue in your neighbourhood, or another convenient location, like to-or-from work/school, and approach the management to ask if you can post a flyer in their centre, and if there is a structure or area for literature, ask if you can put out meeting lists or other literature.
- Once-you've established a relationship you will drop in on a monthly basis to say hi and replace/replenish the flyer and literature as needed.
- If the venue/organization would like someone to speak at the centre, inform the PR committee, we have volunteers trained for this type of service.
- Ideas of venues in the community: hospitals, probation/parole offices, health food stores, medial clinics and doctors' offices, super markets, laundry mats, and possibly store fronts in small communities.
